To provide food, clothing and emergency financial assistance to those in need, while respecting their dignity and fostering their independence.



To help reduce the hunger all around us, Community Sharing provides food to qualified persons once per month and in emergency situations. Food is purchased from food banks and various local grocery stores with donated funds. In addition, food drives at local churches, schools and organizations serve to supplement the pantry.

Community Sharing has a clothing closet that is well stocked with new & gently used donated items; available (never sold) to registered clients once per month. All clothing is clean and seasonally rotated. A coat, boot, hat and glove drive is an annual event where our communities come out in full force to support our neighbors in need.

There are times when a person or family needs assistance with heating bills, evictions, car repairs or other financial emergencies. If the individual or family is already financially stressed, these bills can be overwhelming. Community Sharing can assess the situation and then network with other agencies and organizations to explore available options for emergency assistance, bringing great relief to an individual or family.

Helping clients achieve financial independence is paramount; therefore, we offer multiple adult support services. And, we fight against intergenerational poverty through tutoring programs and homework assistance for students in grades K - 12, knowing that education is the road to self-sufficiency.
