

Empty Bowls is part of a worldwide grassroots effort to end hunger and food insecurity. Local communities plan bowl painting parties where artists coach participants to paint their own design on empty bowls for a donation of \$15 (\$10 for teens/children). When one paints a bowl, it is their entrance fee to a Main Event, a community event, of sharing soup and bread with your family, friends and neighbors. The main event will be held on November 5, 2017, at Bakers of Milford, 2025 S. Milford Road. The soups served will be donated by local restaurants. Denise and Lyle Tyler of Milford are leading this event.
