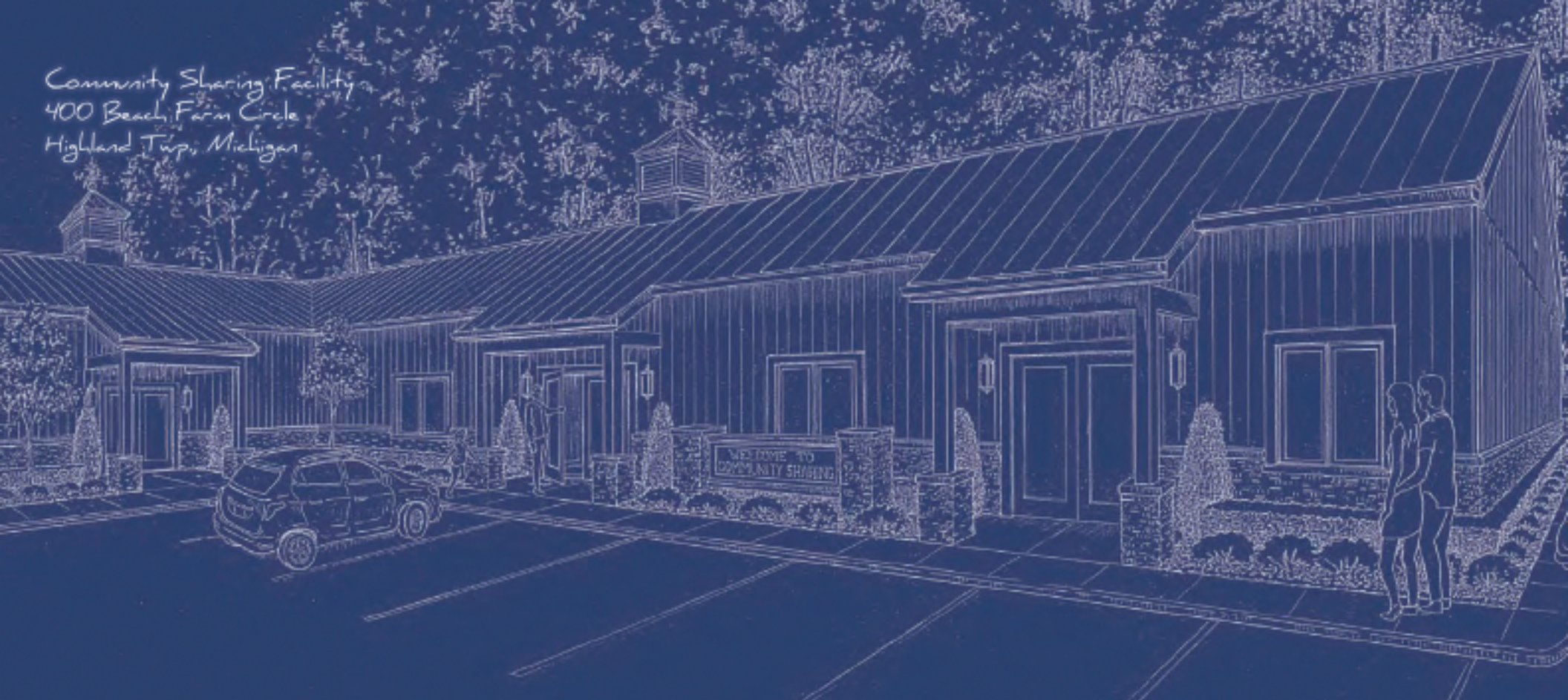

WE HELP OUR NEIGHBORS

When a single parent has to decide whether to buy food or pay a bill, when a senior needs food yet faces a heat shut-off, or a family down on their luck is in dire need of assistance, Community Sharing is there.

Our volunteers see children without shoes, disabled adults struggling to get by each month, and homeless teens needing a warm sweatshirt and food for lunch.

In any given month, 700 of our neighbors reach out to us for help and half are children! Our mission is simple: to feed the hungry and assist our neighbors in need while respecting their dignity.

SINCE 2004

For sixteen years Community Sharing has either borrowed or rented space, while becoming essential to our communities to help those in need. We've moved multiple times, never having a place to truly call home.

Once again, we find that we must move. We cannot renew the lease at Duck Lake Center in Highland, and no building suitable for a pantry is available.

Highland Township generously offered a parcel of land where we can build a permanent home: a home in the center of the communities we serve – the 107 square miles of Huron Valley School District in Oakland County.
