## A Note from the President

Very Busy best describes the last few months at Community Sharing. We have seen a significant increase in client numbers, who have visited the food pantry as well as those visiting Case Work for financial assistance. From January through July, 2022 to 2023 we have seen, about:

-55% increase in family visits
-75% increase in purchased food
-150% increase in financial assistance for Client, rent, utilities, etc.
-Summer Lunch Bags June-July are up 75% from last

Unfortunately, our Cash donations are down 60% from YTD budget.

In recent months we have completed three of our major fundraisers and the National Letter Carrier Food Drive. In partner with the White Lake Meijer, we had wonderful results with The Meijers Simply Give Donation Program.

Just this month we completed major landscape work by K&K Excavating and hosted a volunteer work day with the Barton Malow Company. A big Thank You to the Highland Garden Club for the donation and work to install the flowers and pots in front of the building.

My favorite event this summer was the Food Fight, started by Uplift Milord. They had 7 participating local gyms, (Core 4 Complete Fitness, Milford Bell's Gym, CrossFit Justice, CrossFit Melior, Powerhouse Gym, Milford Carls Family YMCA, In Harmony Yoga and Wellness) and collected over 3000 kid friendly food items for the Summer Lunch Program. The winner of the Food Fight is the KIDS!

Next UP! The Empty Bowl Project on November 5 at Baker's in Milford. The planning committee has been busy getting ready. Please watch the website for more information on donations, auction items and more!

## What's happening in the Pantry

WHAT WE DO: We provide food distribution for our clients every Tuesday morning from 10-1:00 and monthly the 2nd Tuesday evening from 6-8:00 PM and 2nd Saturday morning from 10-12:00. Upon reaching the pantry, our clients are greeted, sent to registration and a volunteer porter who helps direct them through the pantry stations with their shopping cart. With amounts based upon family size, clients can choose canned and boxed pantry goods, frozen meat, milk and eggs, fresh produce, personal care and cleaning supplies, and bread and baked dessert items. All stations are staffed by volunteers. Once the clients have finished in the pantry, their porter helps them out to their vehicle to load all the goods received

**OUR MISSION CONTINUES TO GROW**. As previously mentioned, our visitor numbers are up 60%, from 2022. From January thru July, we provided food assistance to 422 families. When you include multiple visits, this year, that means 1425 families have come thru our doors. Most importantly we have provided food to 550 children. All of this means our pantry volunteers have been working extra hard. We have been bringing back "pre-Covid" volunteers to better serve the clients. We have added extra orders/deliveries from Gleaners Community Food Bank and Meijer. Food Donations from Forgotten Harvest are also up.

We traditionally provide 6-7 pounds of frozen meat. This has been difficult because of a shortage of chicken. In recent days we have ordered from Mattie's Fresh Market, in Milford. Food Card donations from Meijers due to Simple Give program has allowed us to order more food from Meijers, White Lake. Good news price of eggs has been coming down. We also receive generous donations of paper towel and bath tissue from Highland Supply. We received over 3000 pounds from Post Office food Drive, in May.



A local community group, UPLIFT MILFORD, completed a Food Drive in July. Challenged many local gyms to a "Food Fight". Those included: Carls Family YMCA, CrossFit Melior, Core 4 Complete Fitness Milford, Powerhouse Gym Milford, In Harmony Yoga and Wellness, Bell's Gym, and CrossFit Justice! The food drive collected over 3000 items for the summer lunch program.

Every Year, Community Sharing provides extra Summer Lunch Bags for each child. In June and July we have provided over 225 kids food bags. Besides some standard children friendly lunch items, the bags also included extra, healthy snacks. We have already started collecting food items to be used for Thanksgiving and Holiday food bags. The team continues to work hard to get ready for the fall.
