Don't get stuck without assistance!

To receive assistance from Community Sharing (clothing, tutoring or financial), **once a year during (re-)registration you must provide . . .**

- [] Driver's License or State ID
- [] Birth Certificate or Social Security Card for every member of the household
- [] Current (defined as within 45 days of your visit to Community Sharing) utility or other bill showing client's current address
- [] Documentation of all household income

Clients must re-register 12 months from last registration date. Please be sure to have the above documents with you when you come to Community Sharing to re-register.

Every time you come in for assistance, you will need to show . . .

- [] Driver's License or State ID
- [] Current utility or other bill showing client's name and address (Current is defined as within 45 days of each visit to Community Sharing.)

Focus Hope - Clients who qualify for this food may pick it up after 12 noon on the second Tuesday or during regular pantry hours through the remainder of the month. Clients who do not pick up their Focus Hope for three months in a row will be removed from the Focus: Hope program.

Bags and Boxes - Please try to bring in and use your own bags or boxes for pantry items. **Re-using bags and boxes is good for you as a Community Sharing client and it's good for the environment, too.**

If there is any doubt that Community Sharing may be closed due to bad weather, power outages, etc. call 248-889-0347 after 8:30 a.m. Our recorded message will have that information.
